1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

12	(b) Use of Funds for Disaster Relief.—
13	(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any limita-
14	tion on the use of COVID–19 relief funds under any
15	other provision of law, a State, unit of local govern-
16	ment, Indian Tribe, or Tribal organization may use
17	COVID–19 relief funds for expenses related to as-
18	sisting communities, individuals, and businesses af-
19	fected by and located within the designated area of
20	a major disaster or emergency declared under sec-
21	tion 401 or 501, respectively, of the Robert T. Staf-
22	ford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
23	(42 U.S.C. 5170, 5191) before, on, or after the date
24	of enactment of this Act.

(2) SUPPLEMENT, NOT SUPPLANT.—COVID-19
 relief funds used in accordance with paragraph (1)
 shall supplement and not supplant any other Federal
 disaster assistance made available to a community,
 individual, or business.
