6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (14) of section
7 5214(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as added
8 by section 2308 of the CARES Act (Public Law 116–136),

is amended by inserting "(without regard to any require ment or obligation contained in such guidance relating to
 denaturing of such spirits)" after "Food and Drug Admin istration".

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 this section shall apply as if included in section 2308 of
7 division A of the CARES Act.
