Administrator Power:

We write to follow up on requests for information regarding the origins of COVID-19 that remain outstanding. USAID has an obligation to be responsive to congressional requests for information.

Following an August 3, 2022 hearing of the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Subcommittee on Emerging Threats and Spending Oversight¹, a letter was sent to your agency requesting documents and information, which we have yet to receive. To date, USAID has failed to provide the requested information.

For this reason, we reaffirm the following requests for information:

- Unreducted copies of the 6,209 pages identified as potentially responsive to FOIA Request #F-00049-21.
- Unreducted copies of any and all records excluded from production under 5 U.S.C. 522(c) with respect to FOIA Request F-00309-20.
- Unreducted copies of all records produced with respect to FOIA Request F-00309-20 as of September 29, 2022.
