Purpose: To require the Director of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to designate an additional high volume port as a designated port under section 14.12 of title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, based on the analysis submitted to Congress by the Director pursuant to the Wildlife Trafficking reporting directive under title I of Senate Report 114–281.

6 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Subject to the availability of fund-
7 ing and in accordance with subsection (b), the Director
8 of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service shall des-
9 ignate 1 additional port as a “port of entry designated
10 for the importation and exportation of wildlife and wildlife
11 products” under section 14.12 of title 50, Code of Federal
12 Regulations.

13 (b) **CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ADDITIONAL DES-**
14 **IGNATED PORT.**—The Director shall select the additional
15 port to be designated pursuant to subsection (a) from
16 among the United States airports that handled more than
17 8,000,000,000 pounds of cargo during 2022, as reported
18 by the Federal Aviation Administration Air Carrier Activ-
19 ity Information System, and based upon the analysis sub-
20 mitted to Congress by the Director pursuant to the Wild-
21 life Trafficking reporting directive under title I of Senate
22 Report 114–281.

23 (c) **AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT DONATIONS.**—The Di-
24 rector may accept donations from private entities and, not-
25 withstanding section 3302 of title 31, United States Code,

1 may use those donations to fund the designation of the
2 additional port pursuant to subsection (a).
