## **A BILL**

To repeal the Robinson-Patman Act of 1936.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

4       The Act of June 19, 1936 (commonly known as the  
5       “Robinson–Patman Act”; 49 Stat. 1526, chapter 592; 15  
6       U.S.C. 13a et seq.), and the amendments made by that  
7       Act, are repealed.
